EPWP Trains Participants in Plant Production as an Exit Strategy

The Expanded Public Works Programme (EPWP) Non-State Sector (NSS), implemented through the Independent Development Trust (IDT), has successfully trained 26 participants in Plant Production at NQF Level 2. The six-month training programme, hosted at the Simama NPO facility in Kokstad Municipality, KwaZulu-Natal, covers key modules such as mixed farming, pest control, and crop management.
