REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE EPWP NON-STATE SECTOR PROGRAMME FOR 2019/2020 AND 2020/2021 FINANCIAL YEARS

The Independent Development Trust (IDT) invites suitably qualified Non-Profit Organisations (NPOs) working on community development programmes to submit proposals for participation in the Expanded Public Works Programme: Non-State Sector NPO Programme.

METHOD OF EVALUATION: A three stage method of evaluation will be used:-

- 1) **Stage 1:** Administrative compliance, NPOs that fail to submit the required documents will be eliminated
- 2) **Stage 2:** Technical evaluation, only NPOs that obtain a **minimum threshold of 60 points** for functionality will be considered further.
- 3) **Stage 3:** Due diligence or Site Visits: NPOs must score a **minimum threshold of (ten) 10 points** to qualify for participation in EPWP NSS NPO programme.
