ALLOWANCES WILL BE PAID TO THE LEARNERS ACCORDING TO THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES AS OF 1/07/04

1. STIPENDS

CETA will pay each Learner a stipend of R 250 per week, for a maximum of 30 weeks during the classroom sessions. The Public Body will pay allowances for sessions beyond 30 weeks without refund from CETA.

2. TRAVEL ALLOWANCES

- 1 to 49 Kms (Return daily/taxi fare, not to exceed R35 per day)
- 50Kms and over (One return bus fare or 2nd class train ticket per week whichever is the lesser). However, on application to the CETA Learnership Manager, he may approve special needs at a greater cost.

ACCOMMODATION

- Only paid where one-way travel is 50kms or more per day.
- Accommodation allowance of standard hostel accommodation at or near the training provider's facilities, including meals, with a total cost not exceeding R 150 per day, unless application is made to the CETA Learnership Manager.
