- Kamoso Awards were launched in Feb 2007
- Purpose: to reward excellence in EPWP implementation
- □ Focus on Infrastructure Sector in 2007
- 3 Categories of winners profiled and rewarded (Best Project/Best Dept and Municipality/Best Official)
- Kamoso Awards embraced as official EPWP award programme







OBJECTIVES

- The Kamoso Awards Programme was launched as a vehicle to recognise Municipalities, Provinces, Departments and Public Bodies that excelled in implementing the EPWP.
- The objectives of the Awards Programme are to:
- Mobilise government stakeholders and partners to increase their efforts around EPWP implementation & strive towards greater heights
- Communicate and showcase progress, impact, and successes of EPWP as a key government programme
- Create a platform to enhance visibility of the EPWP and reinforce its objectives to a broader audience; and
- Establish Kamoso Awards as an important event on the calendar as recognisable as other national award programmes







SELECTION CRITERIA

- **□Who is eligible to apply:**
 - □ All implementers of EPWP programmes & projects throughout South Africa
 - Implementers under EPWP sectors
 - National departments, provinces and Municipalities
 - Non-Profit Organisations







SELECTION CRITERIA CONT.

□General pre-conditions for entry:

- Demonstrated participation in EPWP must be making submissions to and/or be included in EPWP quarterly reports
- Compliance with EPWP guidelines & reporting processes
- Projects to have commenced during the financial year under review







SELECTION CRITERIA CONT.

MOTIVATION:

- □ To apply applicants must submit a written narrative that meets the specific criteria of the category they are entering.
- ☐ The written narrative is the basis on which the applicant will be judged so it should provide all information requested and include photographs and a strong motivation as to why the applicant should be selected for the award (maximum 500 words)
