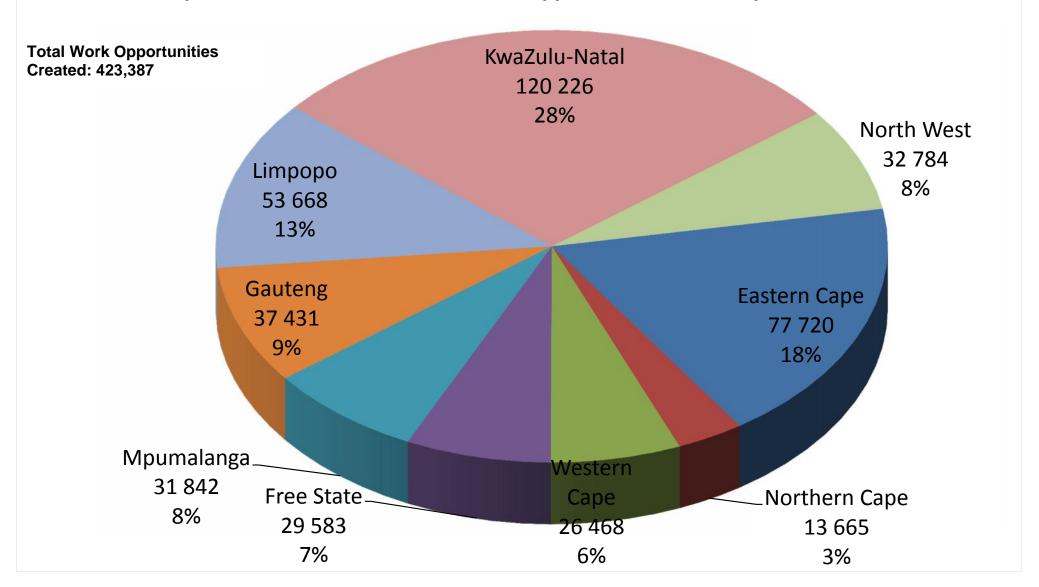

(Cumulative: 1 April 2014 to 30 June 2014)

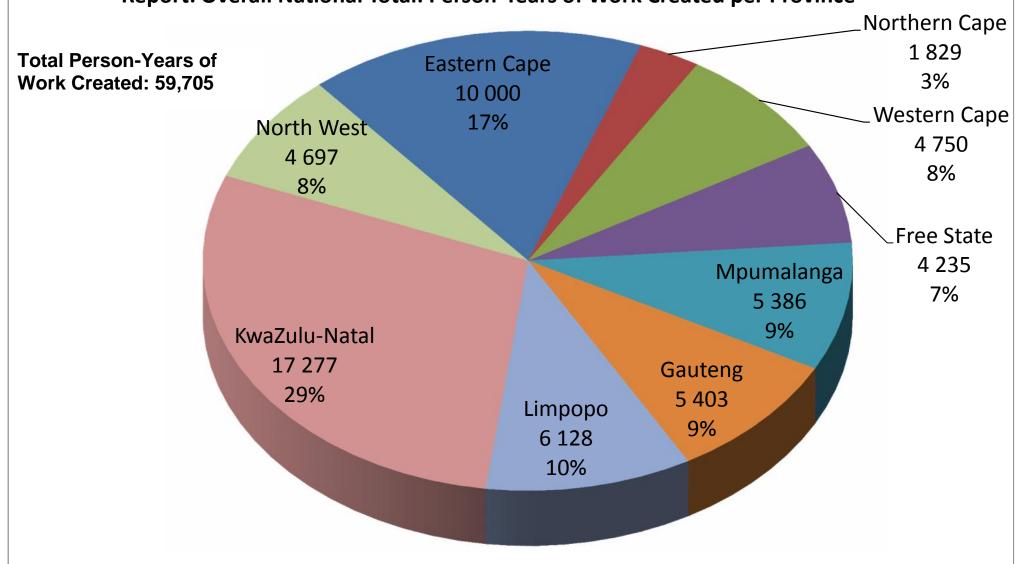

Report: Overall National Total: Person-Years of Work Created per Province

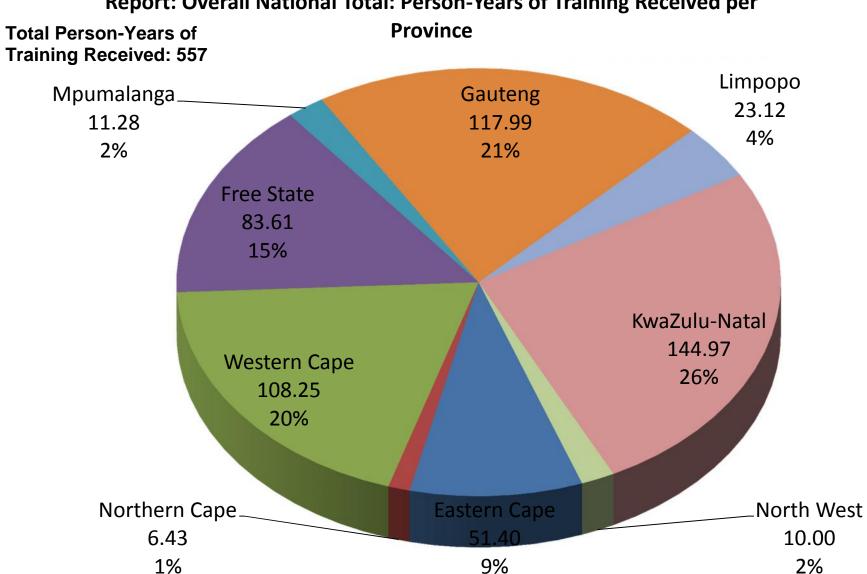


Annexure B4 EXPANDED PUBLIC WORKS PROGRAMME (EPWP)
