Purpose of the Summit

Since 2010, the National Department of Public Works (NDPW) has hosted four Expanded Public Works Programme (EPWP) Summits under different themes and objectives to improve coordination and implementation of the Programme. The purpose of the 2016 EPWP Summit is to:

- a) Review and report progress since the launch of EPWP phase 3 in 2014;
- b) Orientate the newly elected local government leadership on broad EPWP principles and responsibilities of local government to achieve the EPWP targets.
- c) Agree on mechanisms to resolve implementation and reporting challenges and non-adherence to the EPWP Ministerial Determination;
- d) Share good practices on the coordination, implementation and reporting on the programme.
- e) Outline key elements of achieving sustainable livelihood through EPWP.
- f) Highlight the contributions of Public Employment Programmes (PEPs) to the country and beyond the creation of work opportunities.
