#### SIYB BUSINESS GAME








## Trainer Development: Training of Trainers (TOT) Cycle

### **SIYB Trainer Certification Process**

#### The process

- EPWP Trainers organized and conducted a Total of 17 Master Trainer Supervised workshops (9 SYB, 8 IYB)
- Each Province conducted 2
   workshops (SYB and IYB) except for
   North west its training sessions were
   run from Gauteng
- Approximately 170 entrepreneurs
   were trained sourced mainly from the
   Passenger Rail Agency of South Africa
   Cooperatives contracted to provide
   cleaning services.
- All trainers were approved for certification pending preparation of the SIYB training reports.

#### The challenges

- Important for the trainers to continue providing SIYB training to perfect their skills
- Trainer experience with target groups is varied. Some trainers need closer monitoring
- Financial topics such as costing, record keeping and financial planning were difficult of for some trainers. As such content reinforcement will be required.
